Infant Baptism

We have streamlined the preparation process for Infant baptism. If you would like to baptize your infant, toddler, or young child (less than 7 years old), here are the steps.



- 1) Call the Ministry Office - 818-342 4505. Parents arrange for an interview with Sr. Emilie Ann, SND. Interviews take place on most Sunday afternoons and once a month on Wednesday evening.
- 2) Parents participate in one two-hour pre-baptism class that happens once a month. You will receive the dates at your interview. We highly ENCOURAGE godparents to participate in the class. This will help you understand better the special role that you have in the religious formation of your godchild.
- 3) After having completed both the interview and the class, the Ministry Office sends the completed information form to the Parish Office. Parents then call the Parish Office (818-342-4686) to schedule the baptism date for their child.
- 4) We celebrate Baptism in the English language almost every Sunday at 2:30 PM. At
