2010-2011 School Year Preparations: We are already preparing for the 2010-2011 school year! Re-registration forms for returning students will be going home in the January 26 family envelope. The form and non-refundable re-registration fee of \$150 per family will be due back to us by February 17. More information regarding our tuition and fees will be in next week's family envelope. If you are requesting financial assistance, please write a letter to Mrs. Chaimowitz about your needs by February 17 so that we can send you a financial aid request packet. Please send your letter to the school office in a sealed envelope marked "personal".

Parish Tuition Rate: To qualify for the parish tuition rate for the 2010-2011 school year, families must be registered at Our Lady of Grace parish for at least six months, and regularly attend Mass. Mass attendance is determined by an offering envelope count from the Parish Office which must show a minimum of 50% church attendance during a six month period. The envelopes will be counted from *September 2009 through March 2010* to determine next years' tuition rate. (Multiple envelopes turned in on the same day are counted as one.)
