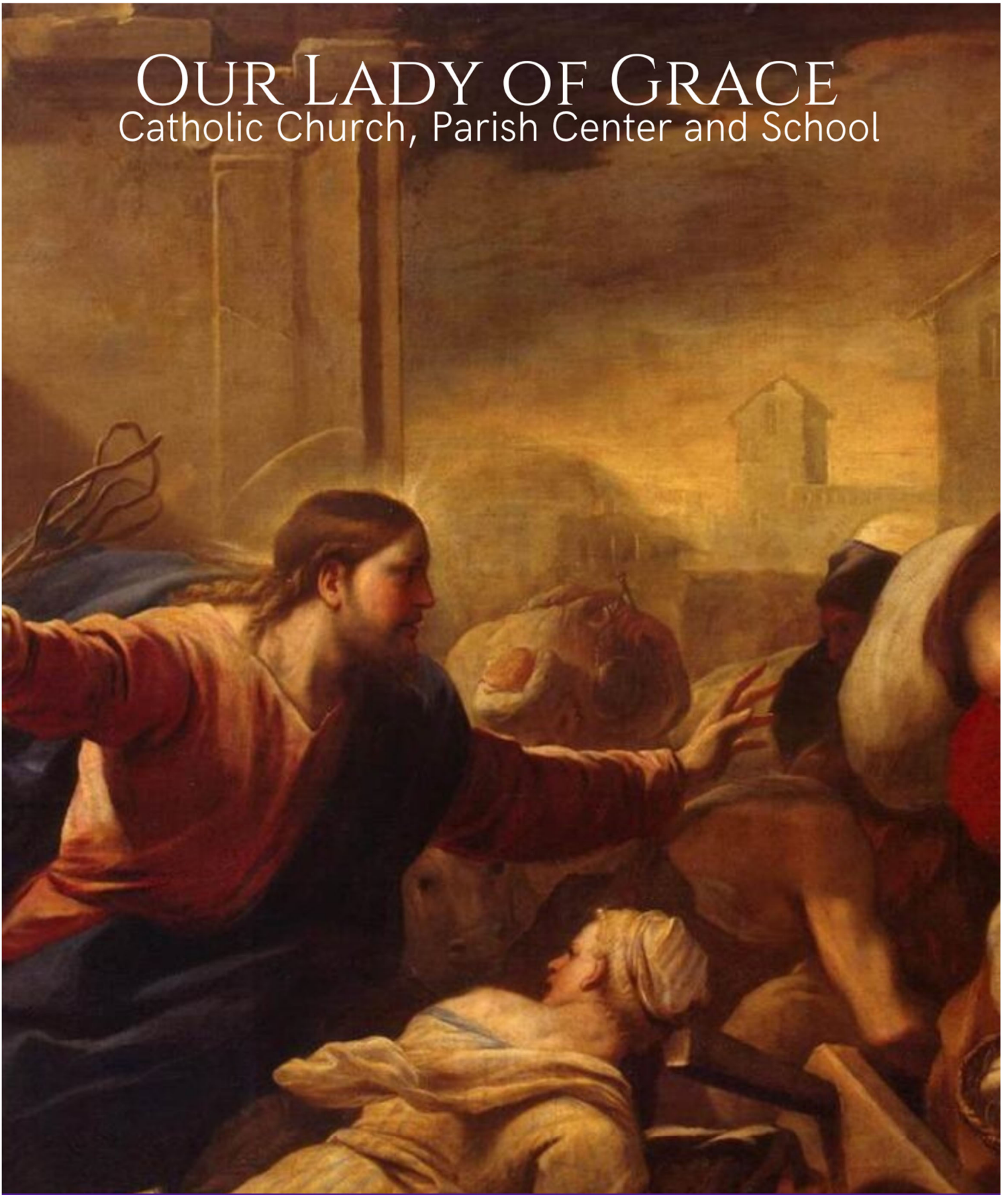

INSTITUTION TO THE MINISTRY OF ACOLYTE

For the last four years, Luis & Claudia Ochoa have been in a formation program preparing them for service as deacons and deacon's wives in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Their training has included courses in Scripture, theology, parish management, worship, human development, among others. Before Luis is ordained deacon, there are two steps a Deacon candidate must go through—they receive the Ministry of Instituted Lector and the Ministry of Instituted Acolyte. Luis received the Ministry of Instituted Lector in February of 2023 and received the Ministry of Instituted Lector January 21, 2024 at a Mass presided over by Archbishop Marc V. Trudeau. The ministry of acolyte is the final step before ordination to Holy Orders in June of 2025. Their ministry as acolytes includes assisting the priest and deacon at the altar during Mass. They also will serve during liturgies, distribute holy Communion and purify sacred vessels.

LENTEN RECIPE OF THE WEEK

This week, I would like to share the recipe of the classic British Fish and Chips. The chips are the English version of French fries. The difference is that the potatoes get blanched (briefly immersed in boiling water, followed by an ice bath to rapidly cool off) and double fried.

FISH AND CHIPS

INGREDIENTS

For the Fish:

- 7 tablespoons (55 grams) all-purpose flour, divided
- 7 tablespoons (55 grams) cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- Fine salt, to taste
- Freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 1/3 cup cold dark beer
- 1/3 cup cold sparkling water
- 4 (7-ounce) thick, white fish fillets

For the Chips:

- 2 pounds potatoes, peeled
- Vegetable oil, as needed for frying

STEPS

1. Set aside 2 tablespoons of all-purpose flour. In a large, roomy bowl, mix the remaining 5 tablespoons all-purpose flour with 7 tablespoons cornstarch and 1 teaspoon baking powder. Season lightly with a tiny pinch of fine salt and freshly ground black pepper.
2. Using a fork to whisk continuously, add 1/3 cup cold dark beer and 1/3 cup cold sparkling water to the flour mixture and continue mixing until you have a thick, smooth batter. Place the batter in the fridge to rest for 30 minutes to 1 hour.
3. Meanwhile, cut 2-pounds peeled potatoes into a little less than 1/2-inch-thick slices, then slice these into 1/2-inch-wide sticks. Place the chips into a colander and rinse under cold water. Prepare the fish with a bit of salt.
4. Cover the fish fillets with flour and batter before frying. For the chips, once these are cooled off, place them inside the oven at 400 F.

RECETA DE CUARESMA SEMANAL

Esta semana me gustaría compartir la receta del clásico Fish and Chips británico. Los chips son la versión inglesa de las papas fritas. La diferencia es que las papas se blanquean (se sumergen brevemente en agua hirviendo, seguido de un baño de hielo para que se enfríen rápidamente) y se fríen dos veces.

FISH AND CHIPS

INGREDIENTES

7 cucharadas de harina para todo uso, cantidad dividida
 7 cucharadas de maicena
 1 cucharadita de levadura en polvo
 Sal fina, al gusto.
 Pimienta negra recién molida, al gusto
 1/3 taza de cerveza oscura fría
 1/3 taza de agua fría con gas
 4 filetes de pescado blanco (7 onzas) de grosor
 Para las papas:
 2 libras de papas peladas
 Aceite vegetal, el necesario para freír



PASOS DE PREPARACIÓN

1. Reserva 2 cucharadas de harina. En un tazón grande y espacioso, mezcle las 5 cucharadas restantes de harina, con 7 cucharadas de maicena y 1 cucharadita de levadura en polvo. Sazone ligeramente con una pizca de sal fina y pimienta negra recién molida.
2. Usando un tenedor para batir continuamente, agregue 1/3 de taza de cerveza oscura fría y 1/3 de taza de agua con gas fría a la mezcla de harina y continúe mezclando hasta obtener una masa espesa y suave. Coloque la masa en el refrigerador para que repose de 30 minutos a 1 hora.
3. Mientras tanto, corte 2 libras de papas peladas en rodajas de poco menos de 1/2 pulgada de grosor y luego córtelas en palitos de 1/2 pulgada de ancho. Coloque las patatas fritas en un colador y enjuáguelas con agua fría. Prepara el pescado con un poco de sal.
4. Cubra los filetes de pescado con harina y la mezcla de cerveza antes de freírlos. Para las papas fritas, una vez que se hayan enfriado, colóquelas dentro del horno a 400 grados.

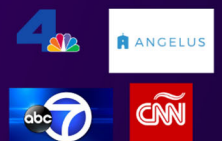

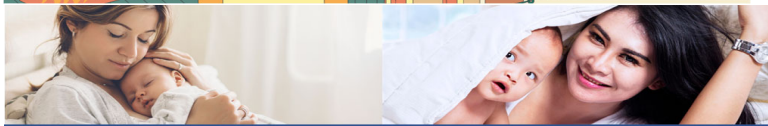

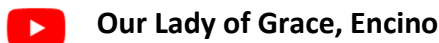

THIS IS MY BODY ESTE ES MI CUERPO

Consistently, human beings have preferred the isolation and separation of sin to the festivity of the sacred meal. Theologians have called this anomalous tendency the ‘mysterium iniquitatis’ (the mystery of evil), for there is no rational ground for it, no reason why it should exist. But there it stubbornly is, always shadowing the good, parasitic upon that which it tries to destroy.” (pg. 20)

Is there any shadow that tries to destroy the good in my life – family relationships, prayer life, honest work, serving others, growing in virtues, etc.? Let’s give it/them to Jesus, who is the Light of the World, and ask him to cast out all darkness from our lives.

Jesus gives Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. When we receive Holy Communion, we don’t receive a “thing” we receive a Person, Jesus Christ... We become living tabernacles. Jesus desires the deepest kind of co-

inherence with us which means that He wants to exist with us in the closest relationship possible – in union, in oneness. Do I let Him draw His life into mine?

EN ESPAÑOL:

I. Consistentemente, los seres humanos han preferido el aislamiento y la separación del pecado a la festividad de la comida sagrada. Los teólogos han llamado a esta tendencia anómala el "mysterium iniquitatis" (el misterio del mal), porque no existe una base racional para ello, ni ninguna razón por la que debería existir. Pero ahí está obstinadamente, siempre siguiendo lo bueno, parásito de aquello que intenta destruir". (página 20) ¿Hay alguna sombra que intenta destruir lo bueno de mi vida – relaciones familiares, vida de oración, trabajo honesto, servicio a los demás, crecimiento en virtudes, etc.? Entregámoslas a Jesús, que es la Luz del Mundo, y pidámosle que expulse toda oscuridad de nuestras vidas.
