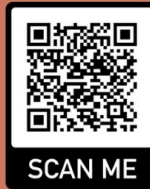

He is risen...He is truly RISEN!!

Tomorrow, April 29, the Church celebrates the life and impact of one of its most inspirational doctors of the Church-St. Catherine of Siena. The cover of the bulletin features our Lord Jesus Christ giving His heart to St. Catherine, which shows just how much Jesus loved this great saint who taught us to "be who God meant us to be" and we will "set the world on fire." St. Catherine of Siena was a remarkable figure in the history of the Catholic Church, whose life and contributions had a profound impact during a tumultuous period in the Church's history.

As the passages describe, St. Catherine was born in 1347 in Siena, Italy, and from a young age was blessed with extraordinary spiritual gifts. She consecrated her virginity to Christ at the age of seven and later took the habit of the Dominican Tertiaries, living a life of intense prayer, self-denial, and service to the poor and sick. Through her deep mystical experiences and intimate relationship with Christ, she was able to blend contemplation with remarkable apostolic activity.

One of St. Catherine's most significant contributions was her tireless efforts to bring peace and reconciliation during the conflicts and divisions that afflicted the Church and society of her time. She courageously confronted popes, rulers, and clergy, urging them to uphold justice, charity, and the unity of the Church. With unwavering conviction, she insisted that those in positions of power must exercise their authority not for their own interests, but for the good of the people, especially the poor.

St. Catherine's writings, including her famous "Dialogue" and extensive collection of letters, also had a profound impact. Her works, written in the beautiful Tuscan vernacular, expressed her deep spiritual insights and practical wisdom, providing guidance and inspiration to both clergy and laity. Her writings on the spiritual life, the reform of the Church, and the exercise of political authority remain highly relevant today.

Ultimately, St. Catherine's life and legacy demonstrate the power of holiness, courage, and unwavering commitment to the Church. Even in the most turbulent times, she was able to bring a "jolt to minds and hearts, provoking conversion and renewal." Her example continues to inspire the faithful to work tirelessly for the unity and reform of the Church, and to boldly confront injustice and moral corruption wherever it may be found.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia,

Él ha resucitado... ¡verdaderamente ha resucitado!

Mañana, 29 de abril, la Iglesia celebra la vida y el impacto de uno de los doctoras más inspiradoras de la Iglesia: Santa Catalina de Siena. La portada del boletín presenta a nuestro Señor Jesucristo entregando Su corazón a Santa Catalina, lo que muestra cuánto amaba Jesús a esta gran santa que nos enseñó a “ser quienes Dios quiso que fuéramos” y “prenderemos fuego al mundo”. Santa Catalina de Siena fue una figura notable en la historia de la Iglesia Católica, cuya vida y contribuciones tuvieron un profundo impacto durante un período tumultuoso en la historia de la Iglesia.

Como lo describen los pasajes, Santa Catalina nació en 1347 en Siena, Italia, y desde muy joven fue bendecida con extraordinarios dones espirituales. Consagró su virginidad a Cristo a la edad de siete años y luego tomó el hábito de las terciarias dominicas, viviendo una vida de intensa oración, abnegación y servicio a los pobres y enfermos. A través de sus profundas experiencias místicas y su relación íntima con Cristo, pudo combinar la contemplación con una notable actividad apostólica.

Una de las contribuciones más significativas de Santa Catalina fueron sus incansables esfuerzos por traer la paz y la reconciliación durante los conflictos y divisiones que afligieron a la Iglesia y la sociedad de su tiempo. Se enfrentó valientemente a los papas, gobernantes y clérigos, instándolos a defender la justicia, la caridad y la unidad de la Iglesia. Con inquebrantable convicción, insistió en que quienes ocupan posiciones de poder deben ejercer su autoridad no por sus propios intereses, sino por el bien del pueblo, especialmente de los pobres.

Los escritos de Santa Catalina, incluyendo su famoso "Diálogo" y su extensa colección de cartas, también tuvieron un profundo impacto. Sus obras, escritas en la hermosa lengua vernácula toscana, expresaron sus profundos conocimientos espirituales y su sabiduría práctica, brindando orientación e inspiración tanto al clero como a los laicos. Sus escritos sobre la vida espiritual, la reforma de la Iglesia y el ejercicio de la autoridad política siguen siendo muy relevantes en la actualidad.

En última instancia, la vida y el legado de Santa Catalina demuestran el poder de la santidad, el coraje y el compromiso inquebrantable con la Iglesia. Incluso en los tiempos más turbulentos, supo dar "una sacudida en las mentes y en los corazones, provocando conversión y renovación". Su ejemplo continúa inspirando a los fieles a trabajar incansablemente por la unidad y la reforma de la Iglesia, y a enfrentar con valentía la injusticia y la corrupción moral dondequiera que se encuentren.

THIS IS MY BODY ESTE ES MI CUERPO

By Bishop Robert Barron. Reflections/ Reflexiones

“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.” (...) Peace will break out on earth, in accord with God’s first and deepest desire, when we all come together in a common act of worship. Aristotle remarked that a friendship will never last as long as the friends are simply in love with one another. In time, he said, such a relationship will devolve into mutual egoism. Rather, a friendship will end only in the measure that the two friends fall together in love with a transcendent third, with some great value or good that lies beyond the grasp of either of them. This Aristotelian principle applies in regard to our relationship with God. The indispensable key to peace – that is to say, a flourishing friendship among the members of the human race – is that we all fall together in love with the transcendent Creator. Only when we give glory to God in the highest – above nation, family, culture, political party, etc. – we will, paradoxically, find unity among ourselves. Only when we sit together at the meal hosted and made possible by God will we truly sit together in peace. (pg. 28-29)

How does this Aristotelian principle apply to my relationships and friendships?

En español: “Gloria a Dios en las alturas y en la tierra paz a los hombres de buena voluntad”. (...) La paz brotará en la tierra, según el primer y más profundo deseo de Dios, cuando todos nos reunamos en un acto común de adoración. Aristóteles señaló que una amistad nunca durará

mientras los amigos simplemente estén enamorados el uno del otro. Con el tiempo, dijo, esa relación se convertirá en egoísmo mutuo. Más bien, una amistad terminará sólo en la medida en que los dos amigos se enamoren de un tercero trascendente, de algún gran valor o bien que se encuentre más allá del alcance de cualquiera de ellos. Este principio aristotélico se aplica con respecto a nuestra relación con Dios. La clave indispensable para la paz –es decir, una amistad floreciente entre los miembros de la raza humana– es que todos nos enamoremos juntos del Creador trascendente. Sólo cuando demos gloria a Dios en lo más alto –por encima de la nación, la familia, la cultura, el partido político, etc.– encontraremos, paradójicamente, la unidad entre nosotros. Sólo cuando nos sentemos juntos en la comida ofrecida y hecha posible por Dios, realmente nos sentaremos juntos en paz. (páginas 28-29)
