Dear Our Lady of Grace Family,

Happy Ascension Sunday and Mother's Day,
Our Lady of Grace community!

There's a saying: "If you give a man a fish, he eats for a day. If you teach the man to fish, he eats for life." In our First Reading, when the Apostles questioned Jesus if he was going to restore the kingdom to Israel, Jesus reassures them that it is not for them to know what "the Father has established...but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes...and you will be my witnesses" (Acts 1:8). God could have given a direct answer to the Apostles, or "give them a fish" to satisfy their curiosity, so to speak. Instead, he decides to "teach them to fish" by giving them power through the Holy Spirit. The word for "power" in the original Greek is δύναμαι (*dunamaí*), which means "to be able" or "to be equipped to" do something. More often than not, God answers our prayers by equipping us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit like fortitude, understanding, knowledge, and wisdom to bear the difficulties of life well and with faith that God will bring our joy to completion, as we heard in last week's Gospel. From the 12 Apostles, we now have the Church of over 1 billion Catholics that has lasted over 2000 years with countless saints in heaven sharing in eternal life and joy with our risen and ascended Lord, showing us the fruits of faith in God's plan for each of us, even if it takes a long time. And even when we might feel like God is silent or distant, the Holy Spirit makes him present to us in the sacraments (lit. "sacred signs"), most especially the Eucharist: the daily bread that sustains us for the long journey to heaven,

from passion to resurrection to ascension.

On this Sunday, we also celebrate Mother's Day (May 10th in Latin America), giving thanks to all the women who have accepted the vocation to bear and sustain life as a fruit of love with their husbands and gift from God. In a General Audience on the family, Pope Francis said, "*Mothers are the strongest antidote to the spread of self-centered individualism.* 'Individual' means 'what cannot be divided'. *Mothers, instead, 'divide' themselves, from the moment they bear a child to give him to the world and help him grow.*" This division, in a sense, if giving her life to sustain a new one in her child, no longer living only for herself, but for the good of her children along with her husband as living witnesses and images of God's love for humanity. Although Mother's Day is only celebrated officially one day a year, we can continue to celebrate the sentiment of Mother's Day by praying for, accompanying, and sharing the joys of life with all mothers as they live out their vocations as protectors of life. May our Blessed Mother intercede and aid all mothers!

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia,

Feliz Domingo de la Ascensión y Día de Los Madres!

Hay un dicho: “Si des a un hombre un pescado, lo come por un día. Si enseñas a un hombre a pescar, se come por la vida.” En la primera lectura, cuando los apóstoles se preguntaron a Jesús si él fuera a restaurar el reino a Israel, Jesús les aseguró que no les tocaba para saber lo que “el Padre ha determinado... pero cuando el Espíritu Santo descienda sobre ustedes, los llenará de fortaleza y serán mis testigos” (Hch 1,8). Dios podía contestarles a los apóstoles sinceramente, o “dar un pescado”, pero en cambio, aleccionó a “enseñar a pescar” por dándoles fortaleza por el Espíritu Santo. En griego, la palabra “fortaleza” en esta lectura significa “ser capaz” de hacer algo. Más que nunca, Dios nos contesta nuestras oraciones por dándonos con los dones del Espíritu Santo como fortaleza, inteligencia, consejo y sabiduría para aguantar las dificultades de la vida bien y con la fe que nuestra alegría sea plena como escuchamos en Evangelio en el domingo pasado. De los 12 apóstoles, tenemos más que 1 billón de católicos en la Iglesia mundial que duraba por más que 2000 años con los santos en el cielo compartiendo en la vida eterna y alegría con nuestro Señor resucitado y que subió, mostrándonos los frutos de tener fe en el plan de Dios para cada uno de nosotros, aunque se pasa mucho tiempo para realizar. También, aunque nos sentimos que Dios está callado o distante de nosotros, el Espíritu Santo le hace presente a nosotros en los sacramentos (literalmente “signos sagrados”), especialmente la eucaristía: el pan cotidiano que nos sostiene por el camino largo al cielo, de pasión a resurrección a ascensión.

En este domingo también celebramos el Día de los Madres (10 de mayo en México),

agradecemos a todas las mujeres que aceptaron la vocación de dar y sostener la vida como un fruto de amor con sus esposos y un don de Dios. En una audiencia general sobre la familia, el Papa Francisco dijo, “Las madres son el antídoto más fuerte ante la difusión del individualismo egoísta. «Individuo» quiere decir «que no se puede dividir». Las madres, en cambio, se «dividen» a partir del momento en el que acogen a un hijo para darlo al mundo y criarlo.” Esta división es dando su vida para sostener una nueva vida en su hijo, viviendo no más para ella misma, sino que el bienestar de sus hijos con sus esposo como testigos vivos e imágenes del amor de Dios para toda la humanidad. Aunque el Día de los Madres se celebra sólo por un día cada año, podemos continuar a celebrar el sentido de este día por rezando, acompañando y compartiendo las alegrías de vida con todas las madres mientras que viven sus vocaciones como protectoras de la vida. ¡Que nuestra Señora interceda y ayude a todas las madres!







THIS IS MY BODY ESTE ES MI CUERPO

By Bishop Robert Barron. Reflections/ Reflexiones

“Our small offerings, in short, break against the rock of divine self-sufficiency and return to us as spiritual food and drink. The Mass, accordingly, is the richest possible expression of the loop of grace, God’s life possessed in the measure that it is given away.” (pg. 30)

“Sin is construed, in the biblical reading, as not simply a personal and interpersonal problem, a strictly human concern. Rather, sin compromises the integrity of the entire created order.” (pg. 30)

How do I approach reparation for my sins knowing that they compromised the integrity of the entire created order?

Let us place ourselves with a contrite heart to the merciful Heart of Jesus, and go to Him once a month to receive peace and forgiveness through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

- Pongámonos con corazón contrito al Corazón misericordioso de Jesús, y acudamos a Él una vez al mes para recibir la paz y el perdón a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación.
