

DEAR OUR LADY OF GRACE FAMILY,

Praise be Jesus Christ now and forever!

The word “Eucharist” means “giving thanks” and today, the Church gives thanks to God for the gift of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the Eucharist, the “source and summit of our faith” (CCC #1324). In our Archdiocese, especially, we give thanks because yesterday, at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels, Archbishop José H. Gómez ordained 11 men to the sacred order of priesthood for the Archdiocese, one of whom is me. Today, my classmates and I celebrate our first Masses of Thanksgiving in gratitude for this splendid gift with all of you.

Today, the Church celebrates the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi in Latin), calling to mind the great gift of our Lord in the sacrament of the Eucharist. Also, this solemnity calls to mind the gift of the priesthood in three ways: the high priesthood of Jesus, the ministerial priesthood in the celebrant, and the royal priesthood of the lay faithful (1 Pet 2:9). Jesus himself is both the high priest and the sacrifice in the Eucharist, offering himself to the Father for our redemption. The priest celebrating Mass offers the sacrifice of Christ on behalf of the people in the name of Jesus Christ. And all of you, the faithful, exercise your royal priesthood by offering yourselves in union with God through your daily prayer, your faith, and your participation in the sacraments, especially Holy Communion and Confession. Together, all three priesthoods of Jesus, the ministerial priest, and the laity work to spread the Gospel to all nations, instructing them and forming them to reflect the same love in which we were created and are destined to share in heaven forever, beginning here at Mass, flowing into the domestic Church of our families, and out into the world. And it begins with you, the royal priesthood of Jesus Christ.

Let us not waste our royal priesthood and ask for God’s help so that we may be the Church that does not move in the world, but moves the world.

On another note: as many of you have heard, I will be leaving Our Lady of Grace to begin my assignment as associate pastor of St. Mary of the Assumption in Whitter on July 1. I will greatly miss the vibrant and faith-filled community here, but I know that we will remain united in prayer and in our royal priesthood under the intercession of Our Lady, Mother of the Eucharist. I am grateful to Fr. Marinello, Fr. Gerald, our parish staff, our parish school faculty and staff, and to all of you for accompanying me in these last few months of my diaconate ministry; it has been an absolute and unforgettable joy.

Fun fact: my home parish (Maria Regina), internship parish (Our Lady of Loretto), diaconate assignment (Our Lady of Grace), and first priestly assignment (St. Mary of the Assumption) are all under the patronage of Our Blessed Mother..

QUERIDA FAMILIA DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA GRACIA,***¡Alabado sea Jesucristo hoy y siempre!***

La palabra “eucaristía” significa “agradecer” y hoy, la Iglesia da gracias a Dios para el don de Jesucristo en el sacramento de la eucaristía, el “fuente y cumbre de nuestra fe” (CIC #1324). En nuestra arquidiócesis, damos gracias porque ayer, en la Catedral de Nuestra Señora de Los Ángeles, el arzobispo José H. Gómez ordenó 11 nuevos sacerdotes para la arquidiócesis, uno de ellos es mí. Hoy, mis compañeros de clase y yo celebramos nuestras Misas de acción de gracias en gratitud por ese don espléndido con todos ustedes.

Hoy, la Iglesia celebra la solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo (Corpus Christi en Latín), reconociendo el gran don de nuestro Señor en el sacramento de la Eucaristía. Además, esta solemnidad nos reconoce el don del sacerdocio en tres maneras: el sumo sacerdocio de Jesús, el sacerdocio ministerial y el sacerdocio real de los laicos (1 Ped 2:9). Jesús es ambo el sumo sacerdote y el sacrificio en la eucaristía, ofreciéndose al Padre para nuestra redención. El sacerdote que celebra la Misa ofrece el sacrificio de Cristo de parte de los fieles en el nombre de Jesucristo. Y todos ustedes, los fieles, ejercen su sacerdocio real por ofrecerse a sus mismos en unión con Dios por sus oraciones diariamente, su fe y su participación frecuente en los sacramentos, especialmente la Comunión y la Confesión. Juntos, los tres sacerdocios de Jesucristo, los sacerdotes ministeriales y los laicos trabajan para evangelizar a todas las naciones, instruyéndolas y formándolas para reflejar el mismo amor de Dios en la que hemos sido creados y a la que queremos compartir con Dios en el cielo por eternidad. Esa misión comienza aquí en la Misa, sigue en la Iglesia doméstica de nuestras familias y sigue en el mundo. Y esa comienza con Ustedes, el sacerdocio real de Jesucristo.

Que no desperdiciemos nuestro sacerdocio real y pidamos por la ayuda de Dios para que seamos la Iglesia que no mueve dentro el mundo, sino que mueve el mundo.

Otra noticia: como muchas de ustedes ya se enteraban, me toca a despedirme de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia para comenzar mi asignación como párroco asociado de Santa María de la Asunción en Whittier a partir de 1º de julio. Voy a extrañar mucho la comunidad vibrante y llena de fe aquí, pero yo sé que quedaremos unidos en oración y en nuestro sacerdocio real bajo la intercesión de Nuestra Señora, Madre de la Eucaristía. Estoy agradecido a P. Marinello, P. Gerald, la personal parroquial, la facultad y personal de la escuela parroquial y a todos ustedes por acompañándome en estos meses pasados de mi ministerio diaconal; ha estado en una alegría gran e inolvidable para estar aquí.

Hecho curioso: mi parroquia de origen (Maria Regina), la parroquia de mi año pastoral (Nuestra Señora de Loretto), la parroquia de mi diaconado (Nuestra Señora de la Gracia) y mi primera asignación como sacerdote (Santa María de la Asunción) tiene Nuestra Madre María como patrona.

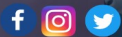

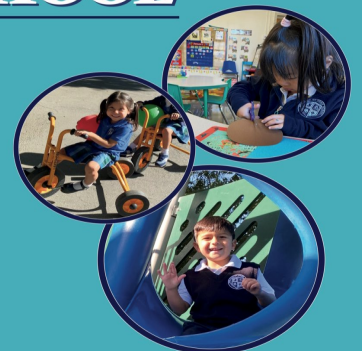

“Our small offerings, in short, break against the rock of divine self-sufficiency and return to us as spiritual food and drink. The Mass, accordingly, is the richest possible expression of the loop of grace, God’s life possessed in the measure that it is given away.” (pg. 30)

“Sin is construed, in the biblical reading, as not simply a personal and interpersonal problem, a strictly human concern. Rather, sin compromises the integrity of the entire created order.” (pg. 30)

How do I approach reparation for my sins knowing that they compromised the integrity of the entire created order?

Let us place ourselves with a contrite heart to the merciful Heart of Jesus, and go to Him once a month to receive peace and forgiveness through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

 - Pongámonos con corazón contrito al Corazón misericordioso de Jesús, y acudamos a Él una vez al mes para recibir la paz y el perdón a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación.
