Meet Father Martin! OLG's new priest in residence

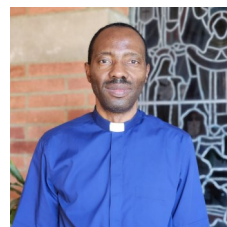
Fr. Martin is the second son of Mr. and Mrs. Patrick Akanaefu from Egbelubi Ezianya, Ngor Okpala, Imo State of Nigeria. His vocation to priesthood came early, when he was in fourth grade. With the burning desire to serve at God's altar as his priest, he entered St Peter Claver Seminary (SPCS), Okpala, Nigeria, in 1990 after graduating from elementary school. Suffice it to highlight that SPCS is a minor seminary, which is equivalent to a high school. In Nigeria, high school begins in 7th grade and ends in 12th grade. This means that his journey to the priesthood started when he was an early teen at SPCS.

Additionally, they were 169 seminarians in their class when they started this journey in 1990. Upon graduation from SPCS, only 6 of them proceeded to one year of spiritual formation. Upon graduation from the spiritual year, 5 of them proceeded to Seat of Wisdom Seminary, a major seminary, to do a 4-year undergraduate course in Philosophy. Eventually, after the 4-year philosophy and the subsequent one year of apostolic work, only 3 of them proceeded to 4-year theological studies at Seat of Wisdom Seminary, subsequently went for internship, and became ordained in 2008. This means that he found his vocation to the priesthood as a kid, entered the seminary at a tender age, and sustained this zeal to be a priest throughout the 18 years of his seminary formation.

Later on, Fr. Martin moved to Los Angeles, so he studies and uses these skills to teach and work with seminarians at Seat of Wisdom Seminary or any other place he will be asked to work. He is a Marian priest, and he dedicated his priesthood to our Blessed Mother, Mary, and the sacred heart of Jesus. These lines sustained his burning desire to answer the call to the priesthood: "The harvest is indeed great, but the laborers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers into his vineyard. Who shall be my messenger, who will go on this errand of mine?" His answer is: "I am here. Send me, Lord."

Querida Familia de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia,

¡Conozca al Padre Martin! El nuevo sacerdote en residencia de la parroquia

El padre Martin es el segundo hijo del señor Patrick Akanaefu y su esposa, de Egbelubi Eziana, Ngor Okpala, estado de Imo, Nigeria. Su vocación al sacerdocio le llegó cuando estaba en cuarto grado. Con el ardiente deseo de servir en el altar de Dios como su sacerdote, ingresó en el Seminario St Peter Claver (SPCS), Okpala, en 1990 después de graduarse de la escuela primaria. Basta destacar que el SPCS es un seminario menor, que es equivalente a una escuela secundaria. En Nigeria, la escuela secundaria comienza en séptimo grado y termina en duodécimo grado. Esto significa que su camino hacia el sacerdocio comenzó en séptimo grado en el SPCS.

Además, eran 169 seminaristas en su clase cuando comenzaron este viaje en 1990. Al graduarse del SPCS, solo 6 de ellos procedieron a un año espiritual. Al graduarse del año espiritual, 5 de ellos fueron al Seminario Seat of Wisdom, un seminario mayor, para realizar un curso de pregrado de 4 años en Filosofía. Finalmente, después de los 4 años de filosofía y el año posterior de trabajo apostólico, solo 3 de ellos continuaron con los estudios teológicos de 4 años en el Seminario Seat of Wisdom, posteriormente hicieron una pasantía y se ordenaron en 2008. Esto significa que encontró su vocación al sacerdocio cuando era niño, ingresó al seminario a una edad temprana y mantuvo este celo por ser sacerdote durante los 18 años de su formación en el seminario.

Más adelante, el padre Martin decidió emigrar a Los Ángeles, por lo que estudia y utiliza estas habilidades para enseñar y trabajar con seminaristas en el Seminario Seat of Wisdom o en cualquier otro lugar donde se le pida que trabaje. Es un sacerdote mariano y dedicó su sacerdocio a nuestra Santísima Madre, María, y al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Estas líneas sostenían su ardiente deseo de responder al llamado al sacerdocio: *“La mies es mucha, pero los obreros pocos. Rogad al Dueño de la mies que envíe obreros a su viña. ¿Quién será mi mensajero, quién irá a este encargo mío?”*

Él responde: “Aquí estoy. Envíame, Señor.”
